Call for Research Papers

Paper Format:
☐ MS Word [©] format.
☐ Times Roman or Times-New Roman 12 font, all margins set to one inch.
Remove your name or other identifying information on/in the manuscript.
☐ Single space the manuscript; double space between paragraphs, headings and text, tables and text, etc.
☐ Center the bolded title of your manuscript on the top of the first page; Capitalize only First Letters of
the Words.
$\square \leq 200$ -word_abstract in italics immediately after the title of the manuscript.
☐ Start the body of your manuscript immediately following the abstract (with bolded , centered heading).
☐ Use as suggested sections the following: Introduction/Theoretical Framework,
Purpose(s)/Objective(s), Methods/Procedures, Results/Findings,
Conclusions/Recommendations/Implications, References.
☐ Use the "table" functions command to prepare all tables.
☐ Place tables and/or figures within the body of the paper "shortly" after their first mention in the text.
☐ Limit your manuscript to a maximum of 12 pages (title, abstract, tables/figures, and all "prose").
References do NOT count as part of the 12 pages, nor does the cover page.
☐ Use insert page numbers command to number all pages, including first page. Numbers should be
centered at the bottom of the page. Do not use other footers, headers, or footnotes.
☐ Prepare one copy of a cover page as follows:
1.) In top right corner, indicate "type" of research—Quantitative, Qualitative, Mixed, or Historical;
2.) Centered, type the title of your manuscript and,
3.) On subsequent lines, type the name(s), mailing address(es), phone number(s), fax number(s), and
e-mail address(es) of all authors.
4.) Save the cover page as a separate file from your manuscript.
☐ Name files as lastname_title of the manuscript.doc
or lastname_title of the manuscript_title page.doc

Style: Use the <i>Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association</i> , (5 th ed.), except as
modified above. Italicize the names of journals, statistical symbols, titles of tables, etc.
