



## Call for Posters

North Central Region of the American Association  
for Agricultural Education Conference  
September 19 – September 21, 2013  
University of Wisconsin-Platteville

Poster abstracts which report a **completed** idea, research, concept, or innovation that **have not been previously presented** at a National or Regional AAAE Research Conference will be considered for acceptance. Poster abstracts must be authored or co-authored by AAAE members. All abstract submissions will be peer reviewed.

Two poster session categories will be accepted – Innovative Idea (teaching, process and products) and Research. Innovative Idea posters must be a new idea or the creative modification of an existing idea. Research posters must be related to a problem, demonstrate a need for research, and address the national agricultural education research agenda. The innovative idea must have been implemented or the research completed prior to submission.

Poster narratives in each category must be of potential regional or national significance focusing in the areas of teaching, communications, extension and/or leadership. A peer review evaluation process will be used based on the established evaluation forms (<http://www.aaaeonline.org/posters>).

Once accepted, authors will be notified of the acceptance of the posters. Posters will be presented at the North Central AAAE Conference. Evaluation of both poster types – innovative and research – will be completed using a “People’s Choice” format.

### Format

The poster abstract should have these heading/sections when appropriate:

#### **INNOVATIVE IDEA**

1. Introduction/need for innovative idea
2. How it works/methodology/program phases/steps
3. Results to date/implications
4. Future plans/advice to others
5. Costs/resources needed
6. References

#### **RESEARCH**

1. Introduction/need for research
2. Conceptual or theoretical framework
3. Methodology
4. Results/findings
5. Conclusions
6. Implications/recommendations/impact on profession
7. References

### **Proposal Format:**

Include a cover page. The cover page should contain poster abstract title, author name, mailing address, phone number, and e-mail address of the authors. All information on the cover page should be centered, except the type of poster should be printed in the upper right hand corner.

Abstract must be a maximum of two pages plus up to one additional page of references. The abstract must include the title of the poster in the abstract (first line of the proposal second page).

The maximum submission length is **4 pages** (1 cover page, 2 page abstract, 1 page references).

Document must be formatted in 12 point, Times New Roman font, single spaced, with one inch margins. An abstract template is available at <http://www.aaaeonline.org/posters>.

### **Deadline**

Poster narrative proposals are due **July 26, 2013**.

### **Publication**

If the poster is accepted, the poster abstract will be published in the conference proceedings.

### **Submission**

Submissions are completely online. Proposals must be submitted using the online form found at <http://www.aaaeonline.org/posters>. The submitting author must be a member of AAAE (use AAAE login).
