ANNUAL REPORT OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER FOR JOURNAL OF AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION (Vol. 46) 2005

Activities conducted in 2005:

- 1. Coordinated with Tim Murphy, AAAE Treasurer to maintain a computerized database (MS Access) of the 2005 AAAE Members and journal subscribers (non-members).
- 2. Collected subscription fees from non-member subscribers and forwarded checks received to Tim Murphy, AAAE Treasurer.
- 3. Corresponded with subscription services regarding rates, missing issues, and replacement issues.
- 4. Coordinated with Greg Miller, AAAE Editor, to make ready each issue of Volume 46 of the Journal of Agricultural Education.
- 5. Coordinated with Mike Swan, Chair Editing-Managing Board; Greg Miller, AAAE Editor; and Vickie Marriot at IMS, to make revisions for the cover of Volume 46 of the <u>Journal of Agricultural Education</u>.
- 6. Arranged for printing and mailing of four issues of Volume 46 of the <u>Journal of Agricultural Education</u> with Instructional Materials Service at Texas A&M University. I worked with Vickie Marriot at IMS.
- 7. Corresponded with members and subscribers requesting issues of the <u>Journal of Agricultural Education</u> that had not been received or were missing. Mailed missing issues. Mailed complimentary issues to authors when sufficient copies were available.
- 8. Mailed a copy of the <u>Journal of Agricultural Education</u> each quarter to Sandra Kerka, Associate Director/Editor, ERIC Clearinghouse on Adult, Career, and Vocational Education for inclusion into the ERIC system even though ERIC was undergoing a reorganization; to Debra Seleska, ProQuest Periodicals, for periodical index; and to ISI for possible inclusion in their index. These issues are complimentary through AAAE. ERIC did not index the issues for 2005. I have contacted them and requested that they resume indexing of the JAE. They are behind in their business and promised to review the request as soon as they can. They may or may not decide to index JAE.
- 9. Approximately 475 issues of Vol. 46 were printed. Back issues are available at a cost of \$10.00 each, including postage.
- 10. A total of 436 issues of Vol. 46, No. 4 were mailed to members, subscribers, and indexing services. There was an increase in the number of member subscriptions from 342 in 2004 to 352 in 2005. Non-member subscriptions declined from 91 in 2004 to 82 in 2005.
- 11. It is recommended that non-member subscriptions remain the same for Volume 48 (2007). The present rate is \$120 for non-members (domestic) and \$150 for non-members (international).
- 12. It is recommended that 2007-2009 Editorial Review Board members for the three regions (two persons per region) be identified by December, 2006.
- 13. It is recommended that the first issue of the year be prepared and mailed by mid-February (instead of March) because of the number of subscribers who think that their issue has been lost in the mail.
- 14. IMS bid for printing and distributing Volume 47 (2006) was approved by email vote. The total is: \$19,575. Therefore the budget request for Volume 47 (2006) is \$19,575.
