NEW BUSINESS

The committee presents the following recommendations for consideration by the AAAE membership:

1. The committee recommends that regional secretaries copy all regional reports to the AAAE Webmaster within one month of regional meetings. If no report is submitted for an activity, the webmaster will list "NO REPORT SUBMITTED" for the benefit of those perusing the Website.

- 3. The committee recommends the establishment of an ad hoc group to define research objectives for an AAAE membership survey. OTHER BUSINESS

- 1. The committee discussed the transition of the Website to Dwayne Cartmell from Jim Dyer. Dwayne indicated the transition would occur prior to July 1.
