- 30 minute narrated boat cruise Informative museum




Beaches

- Professional, licensed captain will narrate history, sights, and facts about the Charleston Harbor






Angel Oak Tree

Johns Island, SC

- Free admission
- 12 miles from downtown Charleston
- Gift shop, picnic areas



Charleston Tea Plantation

- No admission charge, only a small fee for the trolley tour
- Education tour of tea factory
- Only tea plantation in North America
- 45 minute trolley ride with a stop at their state of the art greenhouse



Historic Fort Moultrie

- Landmark of the American Revolution
- Located on Sullivan's Island near Charleston
- Only unit in the National Park System where the entire 190 year history of the U.S. military's coastal defense efforts can be explored

Boone Hall Plantation & Gardens

- America's most photographed plantation
- Recognized as #1 plantation in Charleston area
- One of America's oldest working farms
- 8 miles from downtown Charleston
- Tours available- gardens, butterfly pavilion, plantation coach, house tours


