- Abstract should be in paragraph/outline format and include:
 - o Title of the idea
 - o Outline of idea or research
 - Plan for leading discussion
 - Foreseeable implications of discussion. For example, are you looking for feedback? Are you looking for collaborators?
 - A maximum of 300 words
- Document should be formatted in 12 point Times New Roman font, single spaced, with 1" margins and a maximum of 300 words
