Abstract Submission Format

All proposals should address the AAAE Mission of fostering excellence in the discovery and exchange of evidence-based solutions for social science challenges in agriculture, food, and natural resources. To submit a proposal, please adhere to the following five guidelines:

1. Identify the type of submission for your abstract on running head:

- Emerging and Continuing Projects - in progress with current and/or anticipated results/findings/applications

2. Identify discipline area(s) for your abstract on running head:

- Agricultural Leadership
- Community-Based Education
- Extension Education

- Scholarship of Teaching and Learning
- Teacher Preparation
- Other

General Guidelines for ALL Abstracts:

- Prepare manuscript in Microsoft Word format.
- Use Times New Roman, 12-point font.
- Set all margins at one inch on Microsoft Word.
- Remove your name or other identifying information on/in manuscript. *For example, use [university] instead of your university's name.

- Single-space manuscript; but double-space between paragraphs, heading and text, table and text, etc. Include tables and figures in page count; do not include references in page count.
- Center the bolded title of submission at the top of the first page; capitalize only first letters of words in the title.
- Use “Table” function command to prepare tables rather than tabs and spaces.
- Place Tables/Figures within the body of the paper “shortly” after their first mention in text.
- Use “insert, page numbers” command of MS Word to number all manuscript pages, including the first page; center number at bottom of each page. Do not use other footers, or footnotes.
- Follow manuscript style guidelines as specified by the APA Publication Manual (7th ed.), except as modified above. Per the manual, italicize the name of journals, statistical symbols, titles of tables, etc.; do not use the underline feature in above areas. Furthermore, turn off all hyperlinks of URL references.

Abstract Submission Protocol

Manuscripts must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. (Central Standard Time) on October 15 to be eligible for review. Note: All submission and the blind review process will be completed electronically.

Submission Procedures for Completed and Continuing Project Abstracts:

- Submit a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx) manuscript via PKP™ at <https://jae.sfulib4.publicknowledgeproject.org/index.php/jae/>
- If you are not a registered PKP™ user, you must create an account first
- In the PKP™ submission process, be sure to:
 - 1) Scroll to **About** and select **Submissions**
 - 2) On the submissions page, click on “Make a new submission”
 - 3) From the drop-down menu, select “Southern AAAE Conference.” *Note: The Manuscript Submission guidelines on this page are for the journal and do not apply to the southern conference submission information. Please follow the guidelines in the Southern Conference Call for Research Papers (e.g., line spacing, page length, etc.).*
 - 4) Check all the appropriate boxes, then select “Save and Continue” at the bottom of the page. Continue to work through the remaining pages to submit your manuscript.
